Shopping

Easton Town Center

Distance from OSU: approximately 20 minutes by car; close to CMH airport

Historic Sites

German Village

Distance from OSU: approximately 11 minutes by car or bus

Thurber House

Distance from OSU: 10 minutes by bus or car

Visit the historic home of humorist, author and New Yorker cartoonist, James Thurber. Visitors are welcome 1:00p.m.-4:00p.m. every day except major holidays. The house is located at 77 Jefferson Avenue, one block west of the I-71 exit at Broad Street. Self-guided tours are free Monday thru Sunday. Museums and Entertainment

Center of Science and Industry (COSI)

Distance from OSU: 10 minutes by bus or car

Columbus' premier science center has welcomed more than 33 million visitors from all 50 states and many foreign countries since it opened in 1964. Columbus Museum of Art

Distance from OSU: 10 minutes by car

Columbus Zoo and Aquarium

Distance from OSU: 25 minutes by car
